
Sister Cities of Greenfield 5K Walk/Run On the Pennsy Trail

Starting at the heart of downtown Greenfield at the Sister Cities Park, the course is a straight out and back and is relatively flat. Located on the roadbed of the old Pennsylvania Railroad, much of the trail is lined by trees and shrubs, helping cool the August heat. Your participation will help support the Sister Cities of Greenfield organization, which will in turn provide travel and hosting experience for Greenfield students and their teachers along with parents, as well.

For 29 years, Sister Cities of Greenfield has been sending delegations of students and teachers to our Sister City, Kakuda, Japan.
